

The Digital Poetry Project is an interactive art piece aimed at combining the cultural and historical significance and healing and educational properties of traditional oral storytelling with the mental stimulation and technical elements involved with the way we consume information today.

All participants are expected to complete 3 individual, 1 visual, and 1 performance poetry piece and at least one stanza or verse as a contribution towards a collective poetry piece completed by all participants. Through the program, 1 page of the Digital Poetry Project website will be dedicated to each participant's individual poetry pieces where participants will be able to feature any visual representations of their poem, their self, or an aspect of their life. Visual representations may or may not be animated by the project coordinator based on discussions with individual participants regarding their work.

Therefore, each participant is expected to attend ALL 16 in-person sessions. Each participant is also expected to produce 2 separate voice recordings directed by the project coordinators, a visual depiction of their handwriting, at least three visual and/or tangible items of cultural significance, and at least five visual and/or tangible symbolic items of personal significance.

Applications must be completed by August 31, 2023, at 11:59 PM (PST). Upon receiving a notification of program acceptance via email, each participant is expected to sign an official agreement to establish an understanding of these expectations.
